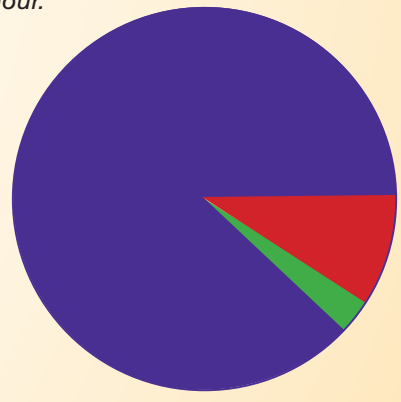


## 2010 Financial Report

## VISION STATEMENT

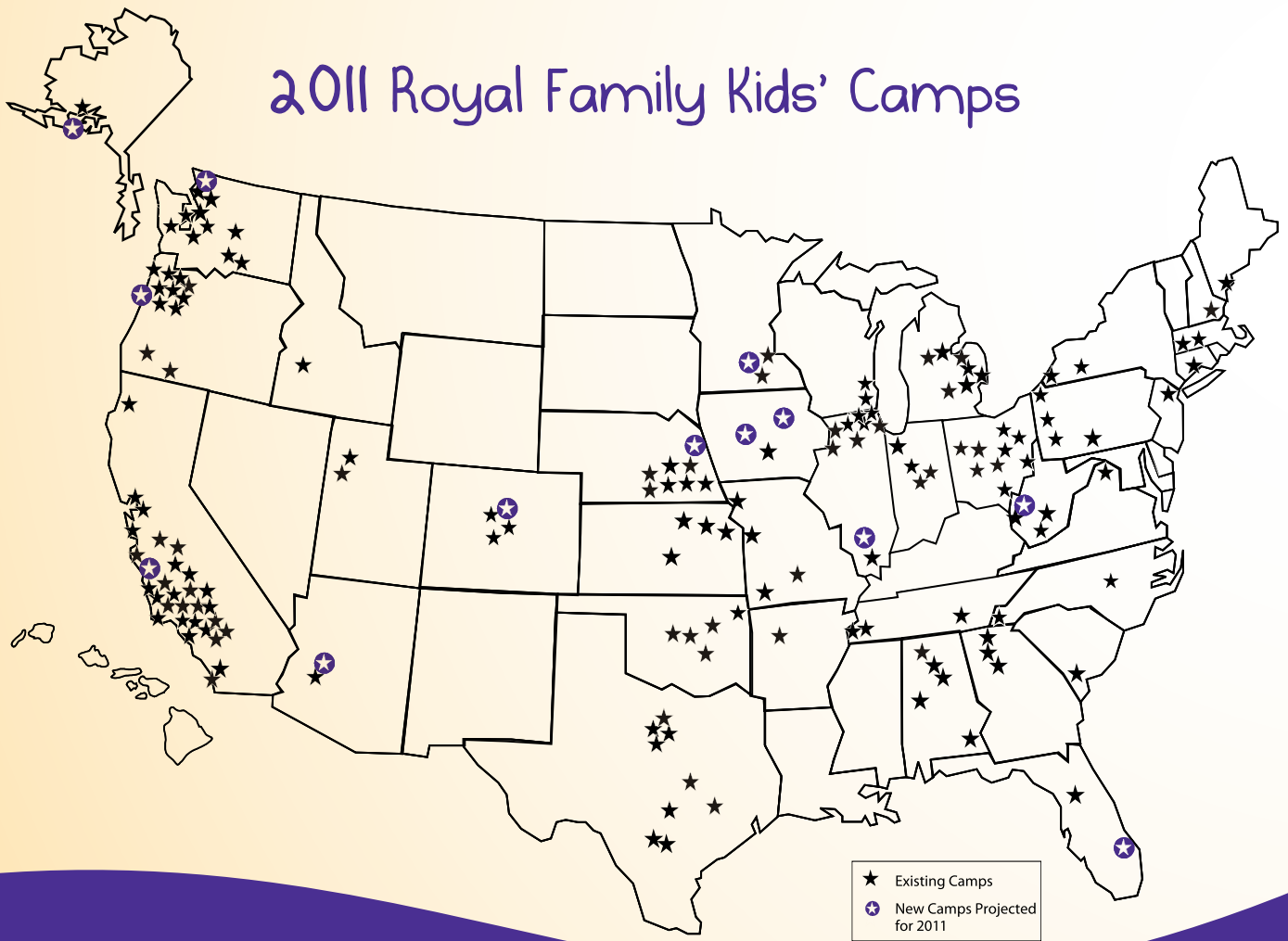
To see 100,000 kids in foster care served by Royal Family Kids' Camps each year.
